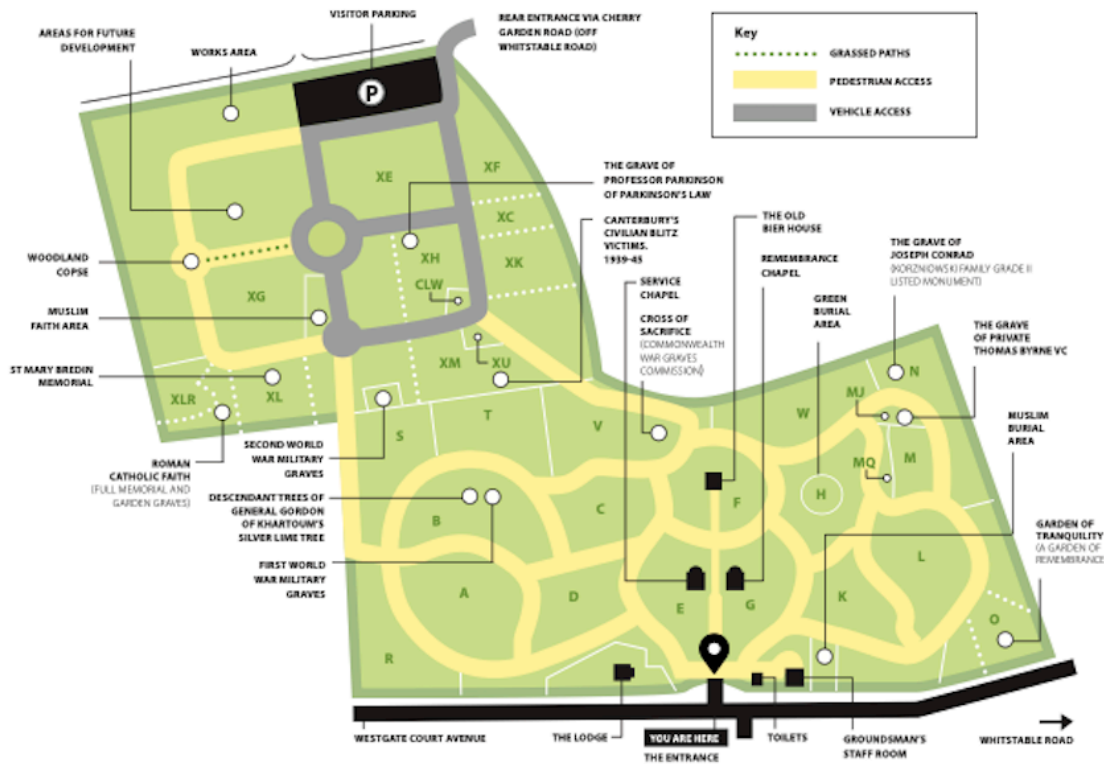

Canterbury Cemetery

This cemetery is dedicated to the peaceful rest and sanctity of those who have been buried here and provides a tranquil and beautiful environment for those who visit. Please co-operate and follow these regulations:

- Road gates open by 8.30am and locked by 4.30pm (Monday to Friday inclusive). Pedestrian access is always available.
- Access - Old cemetery area - no unauthorised vehicles except staff, delivery or contractors' vehicles.
- New cemetery area at the rear - visitors' vehicles permitted, subject to funeral corteges which take precedence.
- No dogs are allowed in the grounds, except registered assistance dogs.
- No cycling - please dismount and push your bicycle.
- Children under 12 years or under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Interments and scattering of cremated remains only by appointment with cemetery officers.
- Stay away from opened graves and work in progress.
- Avoid the use of plastic flowers, non-biodegradable tributes and cellophane wrappings.
- Use the litter bins provided or dispose of your litter at home.
- Seasonal tributes will be removed four weeks after the festival.
- Anti-social behaviour and disrespect will not be tolerated and will be immediately reported to the Police.
- Visitors are asked to report such incidents.
- Faded or decayed floral tributes will be removed.
